Food Policy

Heathlands adheres strictly to Kashrut, the Jewish Dietary law and a basic tenet of Jewish religious observance.

It is forbidden to bring onto the premises any food that is not Kosher.

Only products with a 'hechsher' (kosher certification) or purchased from a kosher supervised outlet or permitted in a recognised Beth Din Kashrut Guide may be brought onto the premises.

Food prepared at home may NOT be brought in.

Food products sold in the Tuck Shop are Kosher (although some may contain non-supervised milk).

These rules apply in ALL areas of 'The Heathlands Village' and to ALL residents, staff and visitors.

Any query must be referred to the Religious Director.
